2. *Purchasing Power Parity (PPP)* GDP accounts for the relative effective domestic purchasing power of the average producer or consumer within an economy. It is a better indicator for the propensity of businesses to purchase software
3. *Nominal* GDP converts the value of goods and services using a global currency exchange rates at a fixed rate in time.
4. Populations are from Wikipedia table from "*List of countries by population* ." Most are from UN estimates and there is some variation in dates. USA is estimate from 1 Jan 2009
5. Excluding Russia, Turkey, Ukraine and Central Asian Countries
